Call to Order

A meeting of the Oregon Cybersecurity Advisory Council was held on Wednesday, October 16, 2019. Discussion. Dennis Tomlin gave a brief update on interesting cybersecurity news and discussed the increasing number of ransomware attacks including a recent \$12M ransomware attack.

Discussion. Council members gave updates on upcoming events. Kerri Fry gave an update on the upcoming JLCIMT session on ransomware. A spot has been reserved for Kerri to speak regarding OCAC's response. She is planning to attend and asked other council members if they were interested in attending. Brian Ventura and Dennis Tomlin both volunteered to attend and speak. In addition, Dennis Tomlin made an announcement that Theresa Masse has left the Port of Portland and is now with the Office of Homeland Security.

3) Approval of Minutes

Discussion. Reviewed and approved minutes from last month's OCAC meeting.

Voting: Michael Gutsche motioned to approve the minutes, Dennis Tomlin seconded the motion, and the Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the previous meeting.

4) Update on Gary Johnson/State of Oregon Meeting

Discussion: Charlie Kawasaki and Gary Johnson discussed their meeting and the State of Oregon's cybersecurity plans and needs. Gary talked about how important the Oregon Cybersecurity Advisory Council is to his overall cybersecurity effort. His top priorities are upgrading the State of Oregon's security infrastructure and architecture, fulfilling SB90 plus a new edict as of July 1st from the Governor's office that his group will be responsible for all of the State's cybersecurity. Charlie discussed how the OCAC team can provide advisory support and help the State of Oregon's team with their priorities.

5) Update on group meetings with EDU

Discussion: Rakesh Bobba and Margaret Banyan gave an update on the meetings with the EDU group as well as a report on the Cyber Lab's EDU meeting. Rakesh said their main priority has been to hold monthly collaboration meetings for the overall EDU team with PSU, OSU, MHCC and TAO to ensure collaboration and forward motion on projects.

6) ORTSOC & OSU Institute Discussion

Discussion: Rakesh Bobba gave an update on all of OSU's cybersecurity-related activities. He discussed ORTSOC and the OSU Institute. The space for the OSU Institute will be co-located with ORTSOC and is being built out in Corvallis. He described it as a cybersecurity "teaching hospital" for students which provides a great way for students to build their cybersecurity skills. Rakesh said the first customers for the SOC will be other universities and other government agencies.

7) Cyber Oregon Cybersecurity Summit (Bend)

Discussion: Cara Snow gave an update on the Cyber Oregon Cybersecurity Summit in Bend and asked for council members to attend. She reviewed the agenda and discussed the key speakers for the event. Expecting 60 to 70 people to attend.

8) Legislative Preview on Cybersecurity

Discussion: Cara Snow and Charlie Kawasaki discussed the latest legislative updates. Charlie said that since OCAC doesn't have a strong resource on legislative strategy and legislative resources that we should ask the Technology Association of Oregon for help with that.
